The ROSS Program

The Resident Opportunities for Self Sufficiency (ROSS) Program is designed to help adults and youth living in public housing set and achieve goals related to economic self-sufficiency.

WFHA’s ROSS program focuses on education, employment, financial management and parent leadership. The program is self-directed and self-paced.

You work with the ROSS Coordinator to personalize your ROSS goals, and help find local organizations that can help make these goals a reality.

How can the ROSS Program help me?

For families and individuals this may include employment, job training, childcare, improvement of education, connection with health care and other social services.

Persons with disabilities may be interested in job training and placement, education, transportation, and referral to supportive services.

Older residents tend to focus on types of supportive services to maintain self-sufficiency in their homes.

Substance abuse (legal and illegal), domestic violence, and mental health are also areas that can affect all populations.
